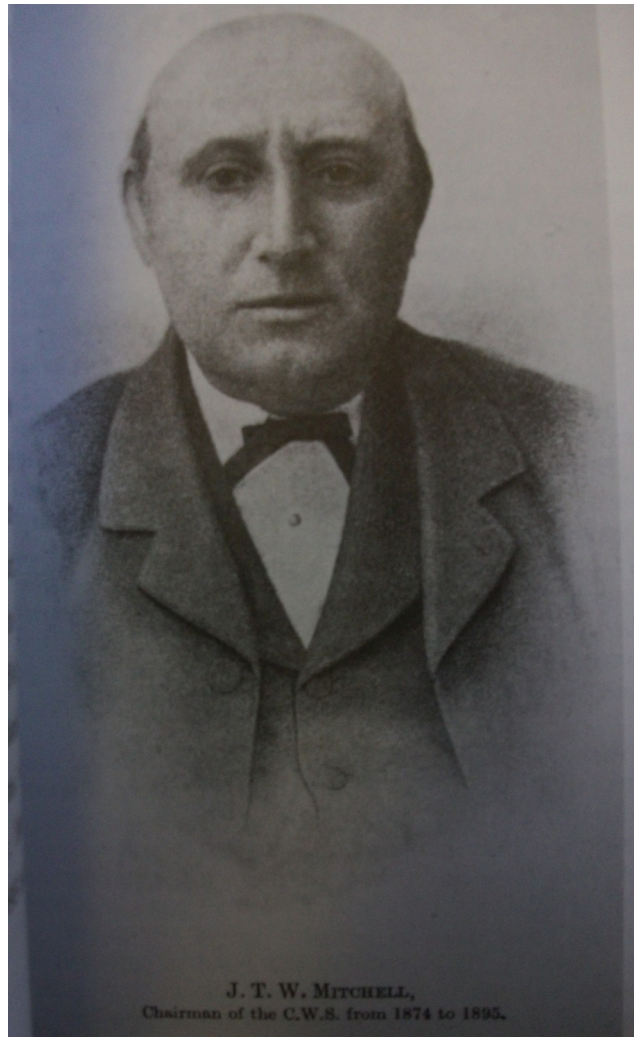

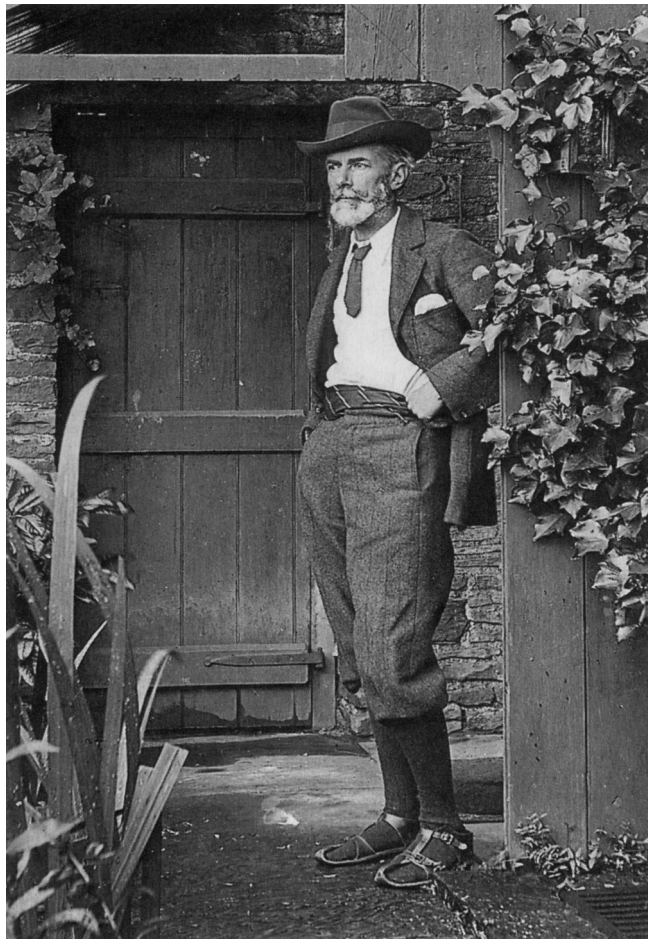

Principle 5 Pamphlets

Sheffield and Socialism will be the first pamphlet to be published by Principle 5. It will be printed by Footprint Workers Co-operative in Leeds. Sheffield and Socialism was first published in 1916 as part of Edward Carpenter's autobiography My Days and Dreams. It tells of the early days of the Sheffield Socialist Society. In this memoir, Carpenter writes about the group's activities, such as opening a socialist café, and of the now forgotten individuals who tried to win people to socialism on the streets of Sheffield at the end of the 19th Century.

It was published as a pamphlet by Mushroom Bookshop in Nottingham in 1993, but is now long out of print.
