## **The Co-op Village**

South Yorkshire Festival Wortley Hall

There used to be a 'Co-op Village' at the South Yorkshire Festival each year. This was a tradition, Wortley Hall being a place for trade unions and the labour and co-operative movement (Wortley Hall is a co-op). The co-op village was an area where all the co-op organisations and businesses put up stalls. Most of the other stalls are trade unions and socialist organisations.

The co-op village came to an end after a dispute in the funeral department of the Co-operative Group. The Co-op Group derecognised the GMB and Wortley Hall distanced itself from anything associated with the co-op. That's when the 'Co-op Village' came to an end at The South Yorkshire Festival. It was sad and caused a lot of upset amongst long standing co-operators and supporters of Wortley Hall. That's the background.

But what about a return to the Co-op Village?

The South Yorkshire Festival is no longer held on International Cooperatives Day (first Saturday in July) It's now in August.

Of course, the Co-operative Movement is a very different place now. Before, the Co-operatives were mainly Retail Co-op Societies like, Sheffield Co-op, The Co-op Group, United Co-operatives, and the Guilds.

But there is a Co-operative Movement to celebrate in South Yorkshire, you only have to see <a href="mailto:sheffeld.coop">sheffield.coop</a> to see that.

This year the SY Festival will be held on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> August and the theme will be the 75<sup>th</sup> Birthday of the NHS.
