### Principle 5 Co-operative Library and Resource Centre Celebrating 10 years

After building up co-operative resources for Sheffield Cooperative Party for many years, the Collection became available to the wider co-operative movement in August 2013. This unfortunately was the year in which The Co-operative Group incurred a financial crisis and was subsequently restructured.

It coincided with the publication of: '<u>Building Co-operation</u>: A Business History of the Co-operative Group, 1863 – 2013' by John F. Wilson, Anthony Webster & Rachael Vorberg-Rugh. At our launch in early 2014 we were fortunate to welcome Rachael to speak about the book and sign copies which were eagerly snapped up by attendees.

What started as a modest collection of books and materials for co-operative education became a substantial and valuable collection, thanks to East of England Co-operative Society. They donated the books and archives which were the legacy of the libraries of the co-operative societies in the East of England. E of E Co-op continue to be Principle 5 supporters. Since the early days, the library has grown as a result of carefully added books and archival resources.

The Collection continues to be housed securely because of the subscriptions from Principle 5 members. The Membership is owner and custodian of this wonderful resource.

**Community Wealth Building in Sheffield**

It seems that when Sheffield Co-operative Development Group (SCDG) was first set up in 1980, the Council had similar ideas to what the Principle 5 team were were discussing at a recent meeting to explore the possibilities of Community Wealth Building in Sheffield. That was a time when local businesses including co-operatives were providing services to the City. One example is the Traffic Systems Co-operative which was contracted to maintain the traffic lights in Sheffield. The story of SCDG forms part of the conversation about Community Wealth Building.

## **Towards Common Ownership**

This is a 41 page pamphlet published in 1983 by the Labour Finance and Industry Group. It considers the case for cooperative common ownership in some detail. Although here has been a few changes to law and taxation since then, it remains a valuable document for co-operative study.

#### **Equipment of the Workers**

In 1918 Arnold Freeman, Warden of the Sheffield Educational Settlement conducted a survey to ascertain how well equipped people in the working class areas of central Sheffield were to take an active part in local democracy. Freeman was a socialist and was aware that without a certain degree of educational attainment people were at a major disadvantage.
